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Most Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. What is the cost of the program?** \$60.00
- 2. What happens next?** All registered participants will be placed on a team in accordance to Parent/Coach expressed choice. Registration Zone/School they attend or staff assignment at random to balance teams.
- 3. What to do if coach doesn't call?** If a coach has not notified you by Friday, February 22nd please call the recreation office at 706-883-1657.
- 4. What should my child wear to practice and games?** Tennis shoes, T-shirt and shorts or sweat pants.
- 5. How many days and what day of the week do the practices and games take place?** Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday.
- 6. What time does the practices and games take place?** Practice will be held before the season for all age groups. Practice times start at 6:00pm or any time before 9:00pm.
- 7. When will I find out what team my child is on?** Coaches will call parents and inform them of practice times and games times.
- 8. Who will be coaching my child?** A volunteer!! The person coaching your child is not getting paid. If you or someone you know would be interested in volunteering please have them contact the commission.

Games: March 16th – May 6th
