- 3. How many days and what day of the week do the practices and games take place? Two days per week; on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays or Saturdays.
- 4. What time do the practices and games take place? Saturdays between 9:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m. (1 hour each) and weekdays at 6:00 & 7:00 p.m.
- 5. When will I find out what team my child is on? The coach of your child's team will contact you about the first practice. If you haven't heard from a coach by the week of <u>February 26th</u>, contact the Recreation Commission office at 706/883-1670.
- 6. How will my child be placed on a team?

 A). The staff will no longer handle placements for players for team selection in this age group. ALL

 7/8 YEAR OLD PLAYERS WILL BE EVALUATED AND ENTERED INTO A DRAFT

 SYSTEM. Coaches will draft according to the player score on the draft sheet. The Head Coach will retain all returning players not re-entering the draft. New coaches will be able to protect (3) players to start his roster, all other players will be drafted. This will better ensure the balance of teams rather than staff placement.
