## Frequently asked Questions:

- When will I find out what team my child is on? The coach of your child's team will contact you about the first practice. If you haven't heard from a coach by <u>Friday</u> <u>February 22<sup>nd</sup></u>, contact the Recreation Commission office at 706/883-1670.
- 2. How will my child be placed on a team? <u>Coaches CANNOT be requested at this age level.</u> Players will be placed on teams during the draft. Players can only request to be with siblings enrolled in the same age group. The only players pre-assigned to teams will be the kids of coaches.
- 3. Who will be coaching my child? A volunteer!! The person coaching your child is <u>not</u> getting paid. If you or someone you know would be interested in volunteering please have them contact the Commission.
- 4. **What should my child wear to the practices and games?** Tennis shoes or soccer cleats, T-shirt and shorts or sweat pants. Shin guards are needed for both practices and games.
- 5. How many days and what day of the week do the practices and games take place? Two or three days per week: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays or Saturdays. It will vary week to week. Saturday practices will be between 9:00 a.m. & 4:00 p.m. and weekday practices will be at 6:00 & 7:00 pm.
